



## **Me and My Community**

Through this project, children will learn about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. They will learn how they are unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

### **English**

The children will participate in daily phonic sessions which will develop their listening skills alongside learning single letter sounds. They will be focusing on learning to write their names using correct letter formation alongside lots of opportunities for mark making.

### **Maths**

This term the children will be exploring the mathematical resources available to them to use during their child-led learning time. They will explore patterns and how to group and compare objects and use mathematical language to explain their work.

### **Understanding the World**

The children will explore the communities to which they belong. These include the school community, family community and their wider local community.

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

The children will have many opportunities to explore how they can use different materials and media to create. They will develop their skills in painting, sticking, cutting, modelling and constructing.

### **Physical Development**

The children will begin to change for P.E. with some support and take part in weekly P.E. sessions with a focus on balance and spacial awareness. During child-led learning time the children will develop their fine and gross motor skills through a variety of opportunities.

### **Personal, Social and Health Education**

The children will be settling into school life and learning the rules and routines. They will be getting to know each other and the staff in school and begin to build relationships and connections.

### **RE**

The children will be considering why the word 'God' is important to Christians.
