**Dear Parents and Carers**

This week **KS2 embarked on their class trips**, both visiting the Ashmolean Museum to explore Ancient Greek and Egyptian artefacts. As part of this, they took the train, which all worked very well even with the dropping off and picking up at what felt like the smallest car park at a station! Huge thanks to all parents for your support in this feat! The sessions at the museum were informative and helped enhance children's learning in their respective historical studies with the staff commenting on the knowledge the children already held.

Year 1 and a few Year 2's have been tackling the **DfE Phonics Check** this week – 40 words which are a mixture of real and alien words. This has meant they have had to do a 'special task' with Miss Curtis 1:1 and having sat in on the majority I can report first hand that the children worked so very hard and did their very best – results will be shared as part of their annual reports.

We have continued to explore the **value of Belonging** this week and thought about it through the analogy of our bodies. We thought about our body being as one but made up of different individual parts – this being like belonging to a community. We looked at the bible extract from 1 Corinthians 12 v12-26 which speaks about the body and the various uses of different parts and how your hand can't listen and your ears can't see – with each part having a key role to play. We also discussed the question would we rather have hands for feet or feet for hands? I wonder what you decide about this!

Next Friday we are officially receiving our **Gold Healthy Schools Award**. This is in recognition for all the school's work led by Miss Curtis, with our Outdoor environment amongst other things. This follows on from VIP assembly with two Councillors attending – please do come along and join us for this very special occasion.
