






Homework – Sycamore Summer 2

<p>Create a mosaic of your favourite animal using an interesting material. What shape will your mosaic be? Paint, collage, crayons; what will you use?</p> 	<p>Practise your touch typing (you could try <i>BBC Dance Mat Typing</i>) to improve your speed and accuracy.
