





Homework – Chestnut Class – Summer 1 2026

 <p>Using your creative skills, create a 3-D model of a royal palace or castle.</p>	<p>Use your historic knowledge to write a 10-question quiz about our topic 'Magnificent Monarchs' – don't forget to include the answers somewhere in your work.</p>	 <p>To combine your developing sewing skills with our current topic, create an elegant fabric crown. Adorn it by stitching on various decorative elements, such as beads, ribbons or sequins.</p>
<p>Visit a local shop and pay for your items in cash – how will you work out the coins and notes that you need and make sure that you have enough change?</p>	<p>You have been imprisoned at the top of a tall tower by a wicked magician! You can get out by climbing down the ladders. As you come down you collect useful spells.</p> <p>You can go down the ladders and through the doorways into an adjoining room, but you cannot go into the same room twice, nor climb up the ladders.</p> <p>The numbers in the rooms show how many spells there are in each one.</p>	<p>Create a poster explaining how you have changed since you were a baby – What have you learnt? When did you learn this? What can you do now that you couldn't do then?</p>
