**Dear Parents and Carers,**

It has been a busy week, with some warmer weather returning too. In **worship** this week, I focused on what it means to feel like an insider or outsider, linking to our work on belonging and community. We discussed actions we can take to help everyone feel welcome and used the story of Zaccheus to support this message. On Tuesday we were visited by the Local Authority to check our **judgements on writing** – this focuses on Year 6. We regularly as a school carry out writing moderation meetings internally but this external verification supports our judgements and verifies our accuracy. On Wednesday, Mr Skears and Mrs Hankins took 20 pupils to a **South Northants Quad Kids** event in Daventry. We very much appreciate the support in transporting pupils to this event. The children represented the school so well, supporting each other and showing great perseverance across all four events. On Thursday, a visitor delivered a **dance workshop** to Years 2, 3 and 4. Ms Hassan, Mrs Hankins and Mrs Freeman are all participating in this year's Strictly Brackley. I believe these children will also be invited to take part in a very special opportunity at this event– please look out for a separate letter coming soon. Children also made a gift for **Father's Day** this week, and I hope these have made it home safely. Today, Maple Class visited **Bletchley Park**, a fantastic place to gain further insight into World War II and enhance their learning in this area. We also welcomed a coach into school to give the rest of the children an opportunity to develop their basketball skills. Tomorrow is the **Croughton Fete**. We do have enough pupils to form a mini choir, but any additional volunteers would be very welcome – we are singing at 2pm! We will also be running some games during the afternoon. Next week is the **Headteacher recruitment day**, and many children will be involved as part of the process. Governors will update you in due course on the decisions made. Finally, you will have received a letter outlining plans for next year. We will be providing **additional transition** opportunities for staff and pupils to get to know each other, particularly in the lower part of the school. We gave England a boost on Wednesday morning by singing 3 lions – we're taking this as the extra motivation they needed to win – hope you are enjoying the World Cup football!
