Welcome back to Term 6 - final term of the academic year – where has that time gone!

This week we began to explore the second of our **core hub values – Belonging**. We discussed what it means to belong and that our different skill sets are needed in our community to be successful – we used a variety of different ways to show this including a toolbox, a football team and a jigsaw puzzle.

This week the Governing board visited classes as part of their monitoring schedule. They spoke very highly of learning that took place, behaviour of children and their ability to articulate what and how they were learning.

On **Thursday Oak and Chestnut** took a day out of school to develop their learning with experiences at St John's Museum exploring life in Victorian times and at St Nicholas Park to think more carefully about their moving bodies. Weather may not have been on their side but both classes had a fabulous day enhancing their learning.
