Complete 3 (or more!) pieces before Gallery Day on THURSDAY 22ND MAY

Create a set of 'Top Trumps' cards about animals. Can you include the number of legs, habitat and the name of their group (i.e. mammal) in your work?



Create a drawing or piece of artwork of a stained-glass window, inspired by a story from the Bible.

Create your own map of our school – can you include a key?



Imagine that you 'fell into a story' and became part of it for the day.

Write a story explaining what happened to you.

Help to make a simple recipe, where you need to use some of the following skills: peeling, tearing, chopping, mashing, grating.



Write an account of some fond memories, using phrases such as 'a long time ago,' or 'last week' to sequence your work in chronological order.

Complete a task which helps to look after your local environment, such as litter picking or helping in the garden. Why is this important?



Write an acrostic poem for the word 'Croughton'. You may want to consider the geography or history of the village or consider what makes it special to you.

Go the shops (or role play this), where your job is to calculate the amount of money you need (and what this looks like), or the amount of change you need to give someone.
