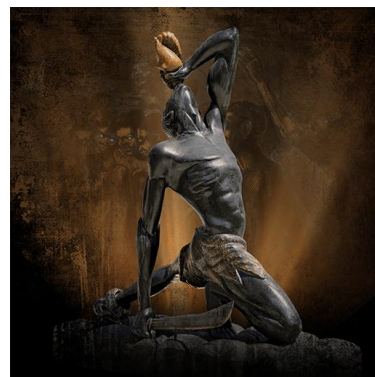




## Maple Autumn Term 2 Homework Grid
