Dear Parents and Carers

This week children in Year 2-6 have had the opportunity to share their knowledge and what they have retained in their learning through the form of **formal assessments**. KS2 will also rehearse their Christingle, Choir will sing at Brackley Care Home and we also have other non-Christmas events too!
