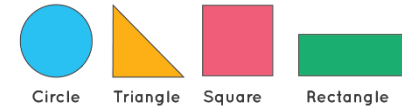
Little Red Riding Hood took a basket of baked treats when she visited her grandma. What is your favourite baked



treat? With help from an adult, find and follow a baking recipe to create some yummy treats for you and your family.

Ask an adult to scribe a book review for you for a traditional tale. What score out of 10 would you give the book? What do you like about it? What do you dislike about it? Would you recommend the story to others?

Go on a shape hunt. What 2D shapes can you find around your house? Ask an adult to help you record how many of each shape you find. Which shape did you find the most of? Which shape did you find the fewest of?



The three little pigs need a new house. They have tried

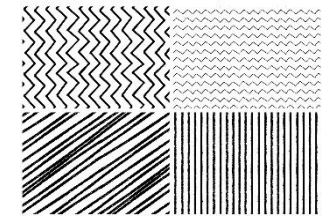


straw, sticks and bricks. What else could you design and make a house from? Perhaps you could use lego or junk modelling materials. If you are feeling very adventurous – you could even make a biscuit house!

Retell/perform your favourite traditional tale. You could make stick puppets, masks or work with your family to dress up and become the characters. Upload a video to seesaw.



Explore large scale pattern drawing using a variety of mark making resources. You could draw outside on the ground using chalk, paint on the floor using water and a large paintbrush, use pens, pencils or paints on large paper.



Make and write a Christmas card for a friend or family member. Can you hear the sounds at the start, middle and end of the words? Use your phonics knowledge to write some of the shorter words in the card (it doesn't matter if they are not spelled correctly!)

Can you find out some interesting facts about our Royal Family? Who is in the Royal Family? What are their roles and responsibilities as a royal? Ask an adult to record what you have found out.



Make a Christmas decoration using salt dough. Can you help to make the dough? Use tools with control to roll out the dough, cut out your shape and paint or decorate it once baked.
