



Think about the colour, pattern and texture you will use in your artwork.</p>	<p>Create a 3D model minibeast. Check that your model has all the key features of your chosen creature. Will you need to add antennas? How many legs to do you need add?</p> 	<p>Explore 3D shapes in your home. Make a list of everyday objects you find which are cubes, cuboids, cylinders and spheres.</p> 
<p>Make a bird feeder to hang in your garden. Watch over time to see which birds visit to feed from it. Take photos or draw pictures of the different birds who visit.</p> 	<p>If you could pick any animal in the world to be your pet, which animal would you choose? Draw a picture of your chosen animal or print a picture and write an explanation about why you think it would make the best pet!</p>	 <p>What animals do you think you could find in your local area? Go on a walk to explore and look for animals.</p> <p>These could be wild animals, pets or even minibeasts! Take photos of the animals you find. Were there any animals you found which surprised you?</p>
