**Dear Parents and Carers,**

Welcome back to school and to our final summer term of the academic year. This is always a particularly busy and exciting time, with a wide range of events, activities and key milestones planned across the school.

However, we are hopeful for better conditions next week – although it will certainly be a busy one, with two events scheduled to take place on the same day!
