

## Are you up for making your way around the world with the 'Reading Miles Global Challenge'



## START 5th NOVEMBER 2025.

## **EARLIEST POSSIBLE FINISH 11th JANUARY 2026 (IF YOU READ EVERY DAY!)**

Collect 500 reading miles for every 10 minutes (EYFS/KS1) or 15 minutes (KS2) you spend reading, either alone or with a parent, carer, sibling or grandparent.

Only one entry per day counts!

Collect reading miles in a special reading passport on your very own reading world tour - a whopping 33,000 miles (or 11 hours) in total!

The challenge is split into seven journeys, each of which finishes in a 'checkpoint city'.

A wall map of the world charting the Reading Miles Global Challenge route will be up in the hall.

A passport to record the reading will be given to you all.

You date the passport when you read.

When you reach a checkpoint city bring your Passport to Mrs Smith— not only will you receive a certificate but you will earn a raffle ticket to go in a special draw — the more checkpoints you reach the greater chance you will have in the raffle.

A small prize and certificate will be given for when you complete the whole challenge.
