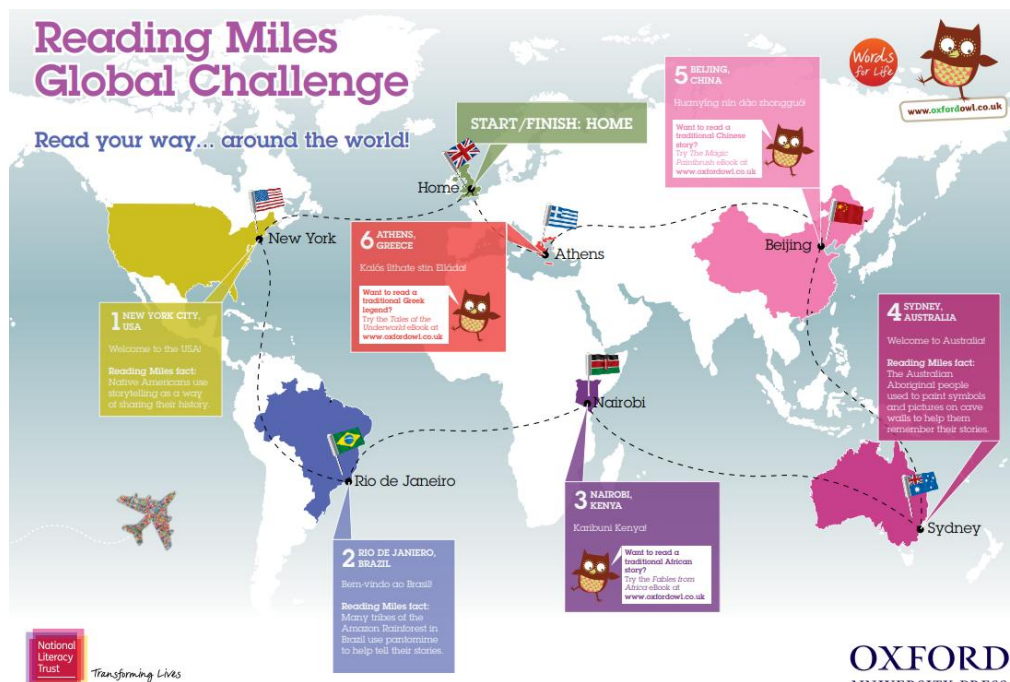


Are you up for making your way around the world with the 'Reading Miles Global Challenge'



START 5th NOVEMBER 2025.

EARLIEST POSSIBLE FINISH 11th JANUARY 2026 (IF YOU READ EVERY DAY!)

Collect 500 reading miles for every 10 minutes (EYFS/KS1) or 15 minutes (KS2) you spend reading, either alone or with a parent, carer, sibling or grandparent.

Only one entry per day counts!

Collect reading miles in a special reading passport on your very own reading world tour - a whopping 33,000 miles (or 11 hours) in total!

The challenge is split into seven journeys, each of which finishes in a 'checkpoint city'.

A wall map of the world charting the Reading Miles Global Challenge route will be up in the hall.

A passport to record the reading will be given to you all.

You date the passport when you read.

When you reach a checkpoint city bring your Passport to Mrs Smith– not only will you receive a certificate but you will earn a raffle ticket to go in a special draw – the more checkpoints you reach the greater chance you will have in the raffle.

A small prize and certificate will be given for when you complete the whole challenge.
