Dear Parents and Carers,

Well, that week flew by! A fabulous week with plenty of learning and exploring taking place. I enjoyed a great morning in Beech today where we learnt about Chinese New Year, discovered more about the Year of the Rabbit and completed a variety of different tasks including noodle tasting using chopsticks. I also spent time in Sycamore and Chestnut this week and next Friday I will be teaching Maple class and Miss Davis will have some time to look at the curriculum areas she is leading in the school.

We welcomed Mr Stuart Smith (no relation) to our school team this week as our new Site Supervisor. He has already been a very visible face around school and has sorted and fixed many things for us which is amazing. There are statutory duties he will be doing as well as jobs to enhance school.
