Take photos or bring it in on Gallery Day.</p> 	<p>Create a fact file about one of these: Ancient Sumer, Ancient Egypt Indus Valley, Ancient China, Ancient Vedic civilisation. Include time period, location, calendar, beliefs, achievements.</p>
<p>Create a narrative based on an ancient civilisation. Remember to use punctuation and paragraphs. You could also use repetition, alliteration, short sentences, onomatopoeias, fronted adverbials for impact!</p>	<p>Build a model of something related to Ancient Egypt. The Great Pyramid, Luxor Temple, Colossi of Memnon, or even a 3D map. What material/s will you use? Bring in the model or a photo of it.</p>	<p>Conduct a practical science experiment about light and shadows. Present your findings in a table and include photos, if possible, then write a paragraph to explain what you have found out.</p>
<p>Go for a walk, taking photos of interesting shadows. Will I be able to guess what made the shadow?</p> 	<p>Make a resource to help you remember one of the times tables that you find challenging.</p>	<p>Create an ancient civilisation mood board or collage.</p>
