Ask someone to do poses for you and create quick sketches of them, using your knowledge and techniques from lessons. You could use pencil, pen, chalk, charcoal.

Bake something with a summer theme – beach, insects, holiday, sunshine! Take photos or bring it in on Gallery Day.

Create a fact file about one of these: Ancient Sumer, Ancient Egypt Indus Valley, Ancient China, Ancient Vedic civilisation. Include time period, location, calendar, beliefs, achievements.

Create a narrative based on an ancient civilisation.
Remember to use punctuation and paragraphs. You could also use repetition, alliteration, short sentences, onomatopoeias, fronted adverbials for impact!

Build a model of something related to Ancient Egypt. The Great Pyramid, Luxor Temple, Colossi of Memnon, or even a 3D map. What material/s will you use? Bring in the model or a photo of it.

Conduct a practical science experiment about light and shadows. Present your findings in a table and include photos, if possible, then write a paragraph to explain what you have found out.

Go for a walk, taking photos of interesting shadows. Will I be able to guess what made the shadow?
