This week we looked at the story of the **Lost Sheep in Collective Worship** as part of our work on Love. We thought about love as an action and how we can show this in different ways. We will now turn our attention to Advent which starts on Sunday which we will explore through Collective Worship in the coming weeks.

Governors spent time in school this week and visited classrooms and observed learning taking place, saw breaktime and spoke with staff, parents and pupils also. Today a small team have gone to Daventry for a **Kurling** event to play matches against other primary schools, they did very well and came 7th out of 14 teams. Well done to the **Year 3's** who have successfully completed their **Swimming sessions**. There was lots of success in the pool from the children. We will communicate next week our plan for January in regard to swimming moving forward.

Next week it is assessment week for pupils in Year 2-6. They will complete a variety of tasks as part of this. It is also, on Friday afternoon, our Let's make Christmas afternoon followed by the Christmas Fayre.
